Visitors are expected to please follow current CDC guidelines of mask wearing and social distancing.

August Garden Tour and Plant Sale

There will be an August garden tour and plant sale for members only at the home of Debby Zweig, 85 East Shawnee Trail, Wharton NJ, 07885 on Saturday, August 21, 2021 2 p.m. - 4 p.m. (rain date August 22, 2021 2 p.m. - 4 p.m.) If needed, the rain date will be announced via email.

The sale will have three sections: surplus seeds from the NARGS seed exchange will be available free to members; member grown plants, priced \$1 - \$5, with a few special plants sold to the highest bidder in a silent auction, and lightly used garden books, priced at \$2. Members area asked to label and preprice plants with a tag or tape on the pot. If you have plants of higher value to be sold in the silent auction send picture and description to Melissa Grossmann at <u>donmliss@msn.com</u> or call 908-604-8060 by August 18. Likewise, if you have plants that you would like to donate that do not fit into either category, please contact Melissa and we'll agree on a price. Please plan to bring any of your leftover plants home!

We plan to offer donated garden themed books at \$2 each. Books remaining at the end of the day can be brought home again, or left to be collected by Melissa and brought to our next in-person meeting (perhaps February 2022?).

Please bring your checkbook, or small bills!

Debby Zweig will prepare a bloom list for self -guided tours of the garden; CDC guidelines will be followed regarding use of masks and social distancing. The plant sale will be handicapped accessible, but the garden tour and rest room will require the use of stairs. (There are restrooms available nearby at the McDonald's on Route 15 in Lake Hopatcong, and also a Porta John in the parking lot of the Lake Shawnee Clubhouse (.8 mile from the Zweig's, 4 West Shawnee Trail, Wharton NJ 07885). Members are encouraged to bring their own food, and drink, and chairs.

We will follow the CDC guidelines in effect in August regarding masks and social distancing. Other questions? It remains uncertain when the Haggerty Center at the Frelinghuysen Arboretum will re-open. Committee Chair Noel Schulz is arranging for Zoom speakers for virtual meetings in September, October, and November.

The Covid-19 pandemic has now eliminated our main fund raiser, the annual plant sale, two years in a row. Treasurer Don Grossmann reviewed finances at a virtual board meeting in early April. Over \$10,000 remains in the account. \$8000 will be reserved for the spring 2022 plant sale. A budget of \$2,600 remains for speakers from the September through March meetings. The possibility of continuing zoom meetings for February in the future was discussed, because of the many snowed out events in the past.

The board wishes to thank Carole Stober for her generous gift to the Chapter; in light of declining revenues, it was a delightful surprise.
