Rick Mikula has been raising butterflies and moths for over 30 years and invented the concept of re- leasing them at weddings and other events. He is currently President of Butterfly Rescue International, a past president of the International Butterfly Breeders Association, and past Vice President of the Canadian Butterfly Breeders and Exhibitors and past Secretary and Treasurer for the New Jersey Lepidopterist Society. He has also served on the Board of Directors for the Center for Landscape Design and Stewardship and is a habitat consultant to many schools, parks, businesses, museums and zoos. Rick has written several books including the award winning "The Family Butterfly Book" "The Butterfly Fandex" and "Garden Butterflies of North America" and served as staff writer for several magazines such as "Organic Gardening," "People Places and Plants" and "Environment Pennsylvania". Rick has appeared on many TV shows including Animal Planet, The Discovery Channel, Home and Garden, and as a consultant for CSI Las Vegas. He has also designed several live butterfly exhibits such as The Hershey Butterfly House, Clyde Peelings Reptiland and Dollywood and served as a habitat consultant to many others.

Butterflies are disappearing at an alarming rate. Come see Rick as he demonstrates how to reverse the trend by implementing the latest techniques to not only attract butterflies but how to help them to thrive.
