#### Directions:

**From Points west and Nor**th on Long Island take **Northern Boulevard** heading **EAST.** After passing through East Norwich (Big Intersection with **2** left turn lanes) Rothman's is also on the left. **This is Route 106**. Continue straight on. Pick up directions at the \*\*\* below

#### OR

From the Long Island Expressway take Exit 41 North or From Northern State Parkway take Exit 35 North

**Go North** on **Route 106**, (bear **RIGHT** at the Fork towards **OYSTER BAY**) Continue North until the intersection of **Rte. 25A/Northern Blvd.** 

Make a **RIGHT** turn onto **Rte 25A / Northern Boulevard.** 

\*\*\*The **3rd** light will be **COVE ROAD**. Signs on the right side of the road indicate: **SAGAMORE HILL Historic Site. Continue thru next light, but move into the small left turn lane**.

**TURN Left onto**... **LAUREL HOLLOW ROAD.** (If you pass the Cold Spring Harbor Fish Hatchery, you have gone too far.)

LAUREL HOLLOW ROAD forks.....stay to the RIGHT on Stewart Rd. You will pass a school on the left. At the end of the road make a LEFT onto MOORE'S HILL ROAD Make the 1st RIGHT onto RIDGE ROAD

Follow the road for approx. 7/10 of a mile. You will see a curving white fence. Two mailboxes marked 1428 and 1430 are on the right. (1430 has red, white and blue reflectors on it.) On the other side of the driveway, a sign indicates 1434.

Turn **RIGHT** down this driveway. Pass a house on the left, a tennis court and pass another house on the right and **continue straight down until you get to 1430 Ridge Rd.** 

From the East on Northern Blvd, turn Right on MOORE's HILL Rd, just after Cold Spring Harbor Laboratory—pick up directions above at Moore's Hill Rd
