- Mariel Tribby asked: What plants do you grow in the tufa that is fastened to the saucer? Does the saucer hold water for some period of time for the tufa to absorb?
- 1a. There are no specific plants I grow in the tufa which I fasten to the saucer. See the plant list download.
- 1b. The saucer I use with the tufa does not retain water. The soil that is used on it retains the moisture.
 - 2. Nancy Blois asked: How do we learn about touring your gardens?
- 2. I give general tours of the garden from the end of April to the end of May. Additionally I will offer other tours upon request
 - 3. David Lauer asked: Would you comment on how you make decisions on when to water the various troughs
- 3. I usually water the troughs once a week in the Summer time, and less often in the Winter time.
 - 4. Betsy Bradford asked: How do you control ph in a new trough?
- 4. I never considered the Ph level of the new troughs out of ignorance. Perhaps that's why some of my plants could have died.
 - 5. Elaine C Holyoke, MA asked: The trough with Ramonda and Gent. acaulis got how much sun? Thinking Ramonda on N wall and G. acaulis wanting more sun than Ramonda, Great Look!
- 5a. They get very little direct sun. However, the sun they get typically occurs midmorning. They're located in bright semi shade.
- 5b. Most of my Gentiana Acaulis get probably a half days sun.
